



Placement Examinations

Placement exams do not determine whether students will be admitted into BTVI. Instead, they assess literacy and numeracy levels and determine the BTVI English and/or Mathematics courses into which students will be placed and for which they should register.

Applicants seeking admission into a Special Interest, Workforce Readiness or Professional Development course or programme are not required to have BGCSE/BJC (or equivalent) passes in English and/or Mathematics or sit the BTVI English and Mathematics Placement Exams.

Applicants seeking admission into a BTVI certificate, diploma or associate degree programme who do not have BGCSE/BJC (or equivalent) passes in English and/or Mathematics at grade "C" or above are required to sit the BTVI English and Mathematics Placement Exams.

Placement exams are administered by the Office of Examinations and Testing Services and take place at set times during the year.

Applicants are placed as follows on the basis of their exam scores:

English Placement Score	BTVI English Course
85%-100%	ENG 1102 College English
70%-84%	ENG 1100 English I
55%-69%	ENG 0111 English
30%-54%	TENG 0004 Tech Prep English
Mathematics Placement Score	BTVI Mathematics Course
61-70 marks	MATH 1105 College Algebra
51-60 marks	MATH 1100 Math I
36-50 marks	MATH 0111 Math
21-35 marks	TMAT 0004 Tech Prep Math

Applicants who score less than 30% on the English exam or 21 marks on the Mathematics exam will be referred to the Departments of Academic Support Services and Counseling in the Office of Student Affairs for further assessment to determine the level of support required.
